Summer Leagues 2025 - Mid Season Update (Friday 25th July)

We have passed the midway point in the seasons fixture list with approximately seven fixtures to be played in each of the leagues. A couple of fixtures remain outstanding from previous weeks, so will the teams concerned kindly re-arrange these asap. Alternatively if you are scheduled to play the same opponents later in the season, you can play that game for "double points" and whatever the score is the same score will be entered for both games. Any questions please ask.

Monday AM Triples Mike Davies' team have a commanding seven point lead with Cynthia Whyman and Phil Trump competing for second spot. Mike has only suffered one defeat in 14 games - that being by a single point (13-12) to Cynthia in Round 7.

Monday Evening Improvers League This league had to be re-scheduled twice owing to teams dropping out after some of the fixtures had already been played. The league restarted on 19th May and Glyn Evans' team hold a six point advantage over Lionel Dotchon's side. Glyn, like Mike Davies' morning side, have suffered only a single defeat from ten games.

Tuesday AM Triples Mike Davies' team tops this league as well, but only by two points from Jan Millard with Jackie Rule a close third. The two leaders play each other on the 19th August in what could prove to be the title decider.

Thursday AM Triples The irrepressible Mike Davies is in pursuit of a "hat-trick" as he also tops the Thursday morning table. But The Scorpions are only two points adrift. The top two play each other in the penultimate game of the season on 11th September. Tickets are on sale behind the bar on the morning of the showdown!!!

Friday AM Triples Another titanic battle at the top of this league. The Scorpions hold a two point advantage over Jean "The Queen" Rogers' team, although Jean has a game in hand. The top two face each other on 29th August - tickets already sold out for this clash!!

Friday PM - Australian Pairs This particular format of the game of bowls is proving to be increasingly popular here at Sully and we already have sixteen teams entered for this year's Winter League. The Scorpions - Rutland/Evered - have a commanding six point lead over second placed Trish Smart/Phil Trump with 15 of the 23 scheduled games completed.

I would like to thank all the teams and players who entered the various summer leagues. This period of the year results in income to the club dropping severely but enough of you have made a massive effort to ensure that the club/rink remains open for twelve months of the year. Final reminder that entry sheets for the Winter Leagues are on the club notice board. In order to allow time to set the fixture lists, these will be taken down the first week in September. Prior to the season commencing, I will attempt to contact - all those who have entered their names to confirm that they will still be taking part. New Website sullyindoorbowls.com

Our new website is now up and running and over the next couple of weeks we will be entering the third and final stage of the building process.

Step 1 was the initial setup, obtaining a Domain name and web hosting, and creating the initial pages.

Step 2 was the propagation of the site so that it was picked up by all search engines.

Step 3 is streamlining the number of pages to make visiting the site easier and more informative and setting up page parameters so that pages are properly displayed on both PC/Tablet screens and mobile phone displays. Because mobile displays are considerably smaller, pages displayed on PC screens are condensed for mobiles and some data may be moved around and out of position. So basically, we have to build two websites one for PC/Tablets and the other for mobiles. By restructuring pages we can make this transition from PC to mobiles a lot easier. Stage 3 will be completed by the end of August, well in time for the start of the Winter Leagues, I can then hand it over to the Trustees to maintain. We will also be closing down the sullyibc.com website, which is very difficult to update, but this **will not** affect **BOWLR**.

You will be able to access Bowlr direct from the new site to book rinks, check league positions, competitions and a lot more using your membership login details. Admins will login as normal. To get you used to using the site, we will be holding another **competition** for you to win a £30 youcher to use at Extra End. our bar and Restaurant service.

BOWLING TIPS

Touchers

A bowl which, in its original course on the green, touches the jack is called a 'Toucher'.

A toucher remains a live bowl even though it passes into the ditch, provided it comes to rest in that part of the ditch within the boundaries of the rink.

If the jack should be driven into the ditch by a "toucher" and comes to rest there, no subsequent bowl in the end being played can become a "toucher".

A "toucher" shall be clearly marked with a chalk mark by a member of the player's side. If a bowl is not so marked before the succeeding bowl comes to rest it ceases to be a "toucher".

Care should be taken to remove "toucher" marks from the bowls before the playing of the succeeding end. Should a bowl be played with such marks not removed the marks shall be removed immediately when the bowl comes to rest, except if such bowl has become a "toucher" at the end of play.
