# **BOWLING TIPS**

### Position of Players During Play

Possession of the rink belongs to each side in turn, belonging any moment to the side whose bowl is being played. As soon as each bowl comes to rest, possession of the rink is transferred to the other side, unless a bowl becomes a toucher, when possession is not transferred until the toucher has been marked.

Players not in possession of the rink must not interfere with their opponents, distract a bowler's attention, or in any way affect the delivery of a bowl.

The position of players during play is important. Players standing at the head of the green, unless directing play, i.e. the skip or third, must stand behind the jack and away from the head. The skip or third, while directing play, may stand in front of the jack, but must retire behind as soon as the bowl is delivered.

All players at the mat end of the green, other than the one actually delivering a bowl, must stand behind the mat.

#### OOPS!!

Last month's reference to minimum jack length should have read 23 metres (not 23.5).

BUT—remember, you don't need a builder's tape measuring tape playing indoors!

If the front edge of the mat is on the 'T', then the jack must always pass the first white spot at the head end . For every spot up that the mat is placed then the jack needs to be that many spots closer to the 'T' at the head end.
