BOWLING TIPS - 1

Mat Placement

The mat must be placed with its front edge at least 2 metres from the rear ditch, and the front edge of the mat should be on the centreline of the rink. The back edge of the mat can be moved further from the rear ditch, but it must not be placed closer than 23.5 metres from the front ditch.

- **First End:** The mat must be placed by the team that won the toss before the game begins. The mat is placed with the front edge at least 2 metres from the rear ditch (meaning the front edge must cover the 'T') and on the centreline of the rink.
 - The lead player can move the mat further from the rear ditch, but it cannot be placed closer than 23.5 metres from the front ditch.
- **Legal Placement:** The mat is considered legal if the front edge is at least 2 metres from the rear ditch.
- **Alignment:** The mat should be aligned with the centreline of the rink.
- Foot Placement: One foot must be on or above the mat when delivering a bowl.
- Jack Distance: The jack must be rolled at least 23.5 metres from the front edge of the mat.







The Jack



Do you know where the name for that small target ball we all keep aiming for came from? No? Well, let me share my research with you.

The "jack" in bowls, the smaller target ball, is believed to have originated from the Latin word "jactus," meaning "a cast" or "a throw". Possibly related to the game of "Jactu lapidum", a game involving throwing rounded stones at, or towards, a target.

Some theories suggest that "jack" could also refer to something smaller or inferior, with "Jack-Bowl" potentially being a smaller bowl, later shortened to "Jack".

Shakespeare's play "Cymbeline" (written around 1610) contains one of the first recorded mentions of the "jack" in the context of bowls.

The jack is also known by other names, such as "the white," "the kitty," "the sweetie," "the cot," or "the block," depending on the region or type of bowls played.

The game of bowls itself has ancient origins, with evidence of similar games being played in ancient Egypt and other cultures.
