Membership Categories and Governance

The Club welcomes both playing (bowling and pétanque) and non-playing (social) members, all of whom contribute to the success and atmosphere of the Club.

Membership of the Club is subject to its Constitution and Rules, which define how the Club is governed and managed.

The overall direction, governance, and decision-making of the Club rests solely with the Trustees, who are responsible for acting in the best interests of the Club and its membership as a whole.

While certain categories of membership may, where provided for in the Constitution, be invited to participate in general meetings or other consultative processes, membership of the Club does not confer any automatic right to direct, determine, or influence the management or affairs of the Club.

Social membership is designed to provide access to the Club's facilities, including the bar and social areas, at preferential member rates. Playing members pay an additional fee to participate in bowling activities. These membership categories do not alter the governance structure of the Club, which remains vested in the Trustees.

To ensure clarity, consistency, and appropriate governance, official communication with members—including those within the bowling and pétanque sections—will be issued solely through the Club's recognised channels, primarily the official newsletter and other formally sanctioned communications.

Informal or unauthorised channels are not recognised as a means of representing the views of the Club or influencing its governance.
